1950
Bishop Ralph Hayes asked the four Iowa City parishes to formulate plans for a central Catholic high school in Iowa City.



1956
Rev. Raymond Pacha led a fundraising campaign to build the new Catholic high school. The name of the school was changed from Iowa City Central Catholic High School to Regina, Latin word for queen. Pictured above are three of the parish priests on the site of the future Regina High School.

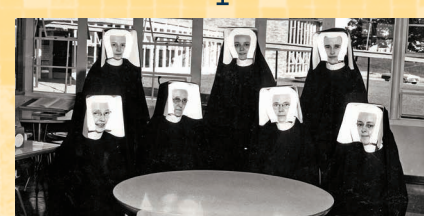


1954
A 105-acre farm on the east side of Iowa City was purchased for \$50,000 from the Langenberg Family.



1958
The last classes graduated from St. Patrick's and St. Mary's High Schools. The two schools consolidated in the fall of 1958.

1958
Regina High School officially opened its doors to 295 students on September 3. Faculty included four priests, eight Sisters of Charity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (BVM) and six lay teachers. St. Patrick's and St. Mary's Schools each continued to run K-8 programs.



1959
New dress code announced in September. Navy blue skirts, white blouses and cardigan sweaters for girls. Boys must wear collared shirts and cannot wear anything "unseemly" like blue jeans or t-shirts.

1962
Athletic field completed. Regina previously used the field at Iowa City High School.



1968
St. Mary's School closed. Students transferred to St. Patrick's (renamed Iowa City Catholic Grade School).



1967
Lay Board of Education established at Regina High School with ten lay people.

Preparing Tomorrow's Leaders

The Regina Early Childhood Center brings innovation and developmentally appropriate learning through our Creative Curriculum program for children ages 3-5. This program includes activities that promote positive self-image, social skills, and learning that will set the stage for continued success at the elementary level. Regina Pre-Kindergarten continues our mission of *Growth Takes Love* with the caring guidance of certified teachers and even more kindergarten readiness enrichment activities.



Regina 6th grade students use microscopes to observe cells and cell structures, and identify microorganisms in pond water.

Regina Elementary School welcomes students in Kindergarten through 6th grade to small class sizes in a safe environment. We are committed to educating the whole child through a challenging and rigorous curriculum that is faith-focused and values-based. Participation in specials classes

include: music, art, physical education, computer, library and guidance. We are proud to teach the six pillars of Character Counts: *Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring and Citizenship* to help instill a positive school climate and a "culture of kindness." Regina Elementary also chooses to add a seventh pillar and teach about the importance of character through Faith.

Regina Jr./Sr. High continues the educational journey for students from the solid foundation they have received at our Early Childhood and Elementary School levels. In addition to the excellent and comprehensive course of study that challenges our students, our Campus Ministry Department, fine arts programs, excellent athletics and extensive extra-curricular activities provide many opportunities for a well-rounded experience that prepares our Regina graduates for college and beyond. Our focus on faith and character development, smaller class sizes, and innovative, involved and caring faculty help lead to our 100% graduation rate.

Iowa City Vicariate Education Foundation established to provide funds for Catholic schools.

School purchased its first computers. Two computer program courses added.

1987

Regina Elementary Center (K-6) opened after \$1.7M campaign. Religious Education program began for public school students.



1992

\$2.75M "Mission of Necessity Campaign" to renovate the high school is completed. Five high school classrooms added.

1989

Regina Preschool opened with two classrooms that served 25 three- and four-year-olds.

1995

Last religious order teacher left Regina Elementary.

2000

Last religious order teacher left Regina Jr./Sr. High School.



2000

Crownie became the new school mascot.



2004

New additions completed from \$5M+ "Fueling the Fire of Faith Campaign." Additions included kitchen, cafeteria, science labs, restrooms, seven jr./sr. high classrooms and a multi-purpose room.



2007

Regina High School remodeled the fine arts wing.



2010

New Regina dress code: navy, white, maize or gray polos and white or blue dress shirts (all with Regina logo); navy, khaki, gray or plaid skorts or jumpers; dress pants or shorts must be navy, black, gray or khaki. Yoga pants and skinny jeans not allowed.

We are excited to share that the **EXCELLENCE FUND*** total for fiscal year 2018–2019 was **\$466,554**.

Because of donors' generous support we exceeded our \$450,000 goal by \$16,554!

Capital Campaign Update



Launched in 2016, the *Pride in Our Past, Building Our Future* Capital Campaign has raised \$4.85 million and allowed Regina to address multiple needs throughout our campus. To date, we have:

- Expanded and resurfaced the front parking lot, resurfaced the front circle drive and replaced lighting in the front lot
- Replaced the leaking high school gymnasium roof
- Built the new First Avenue entrance drive, including extra rear parking spaces and a walkway from First Avenue
- Renovated the 60-year-old boys and girls locker rooms
- Replaced the antiquated bell and intercom system
- Rerouted storm water retention, which was required by the city

In addition, thanks to a generous donor, we were able to build and furnish the Regina Athletic Training Facility, which includes a weight training room, wrestling room, film and team meetings room, and coaches' offices. Although these were originally Phase 2 projects, Regina's Board leadership decided that it was in Regina's best interest to accept the donor's offer and move the training facility up on the schedule of targeted projects.

Now, with new gifts from three donors totaling \$1.85 million, we look to raise the final \$1.1 million needed to complete the remaining Phase 1 projects. Our sights are now set on raising a total of \$7.8 million in the *Pride in Our Past, Building Our Future* Capital Campaign.

Regina has a strong tradition of forming students academically, spiritually and socially. While people and programs are most important in a school, buildings do matter. The education infrastructure must promote the learning process, rather than inhibit it.

To continue our focus on the academic, spiritual and social needs of our students, Regina's Board leadership studied what renovations and improvements would position Regina for future growth. Part of the resulting plan was to build a new Education Wing and to modernize and expand our Early Childhood Center. These two projects are the top priorities of the campaign continuation.

Build a New Education Wing

Estimated Cost: \$3,265,000

The new Education Wing will feature 11,723 square feet of new construction built where the weight room and modular classrooms once stood. The one-story Education Wing will include four classrooms for junior and senior high classes. Other features will include a state-of-the-art science lab, lobby, concession area, athletic training room, and restrooms.

Thanks to the generosity of the initial donors to the campaign continuation, construction on the Education Wing project is scheduled to begin in September.

FEATURES OF THE SCIENCE LAB WILL INCLUDE:

- A Smart Board with 3D projection and virtual reality capabilities
- Lab centers to accommodate six to eight students
- A teacher lab demonstration desk

Renovate and Expand the Early Childhood Center

Initial Allocation: \$500,000

Regina's Board leadership is aware of the important role our Pre-K program plays in introducing families to Regina. It is an important part of our students' initial experience at Regina, and a big reason families choose to stay at Regina for elementary school. Historically, a majority of Pre-K students elect to enroll in Kindergarten at Regina. The success of this program is a priority for the leadership at Regina as well as a key to long-term enrollment growth and stability.



As part of this vision, we have allocated \$500,000 in capital campaign funds to improve the Pre-K facilities and create enough space for future expansion of the program. As the program grows we want to have space available to grow with it. We would like to convert the existing 6th grade wing into a new Pre-K center large enough to serve our current enrollment and leave additional room for growth. Preliminary discussions include secure entrance and exit points, updated classrooms with more space per child, additional bathrooms, teacher prep rooms, storage, an indoor play center, and a STEM room for kids. The extent to which we can proceed with some or all of these Pre-K projects will depend on the amount of funds raised. With your help we can make all of them come to fruition. The ultimate goal of this project is to better serve our current enrollment needs and to increase enrollment in the Pre-K program going forward.

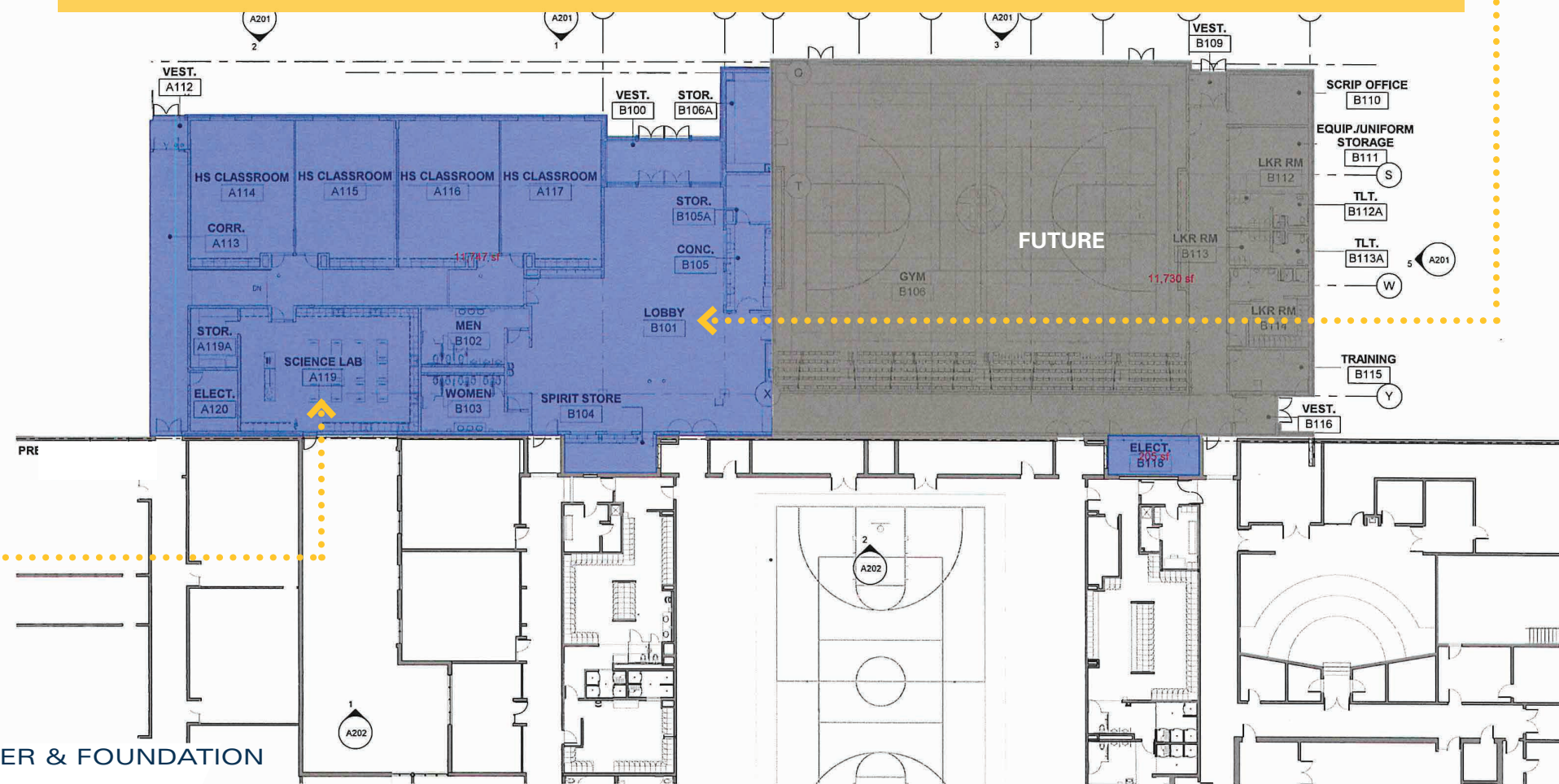
Improve Parking and Roadways

Estimated Cost: \$400,000

As part of the new Education Wing work, we must make improvements to the adjacent parking lot, lighting and landscaping. We will temporarily place rock in the former water retention area to accommodate parking during construction. With strong support for the campaign, we look to make additional improvements including replacing a portion of the driveway on the east side of the school and proceeding with permanent paving of the rocked parking area. These improvements have been part of our long-term plan, but must be delayed until the building projects are complete due to the expected heavy construction traffic.

FEATURES OF THE NEW LOBBY WILL INCLUDE

- Flex space — this area will be used as space for educational activities during the school day, and as an entry point for people attending extracurricular activities such as athletic events in the evening
- A trophy case and donor wall
- Connection to a new gym, if a new gym is built in the future

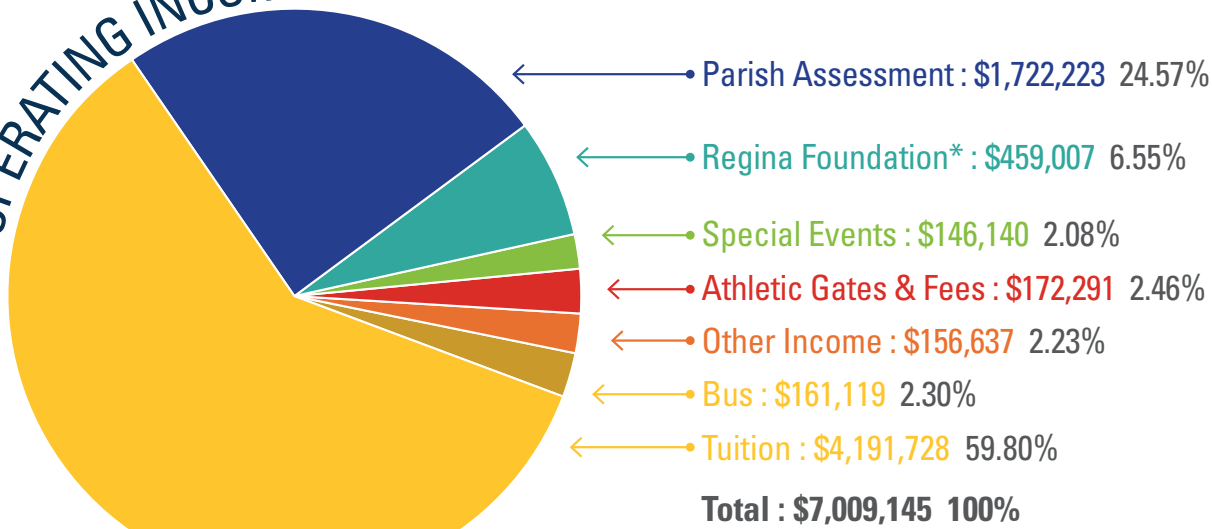

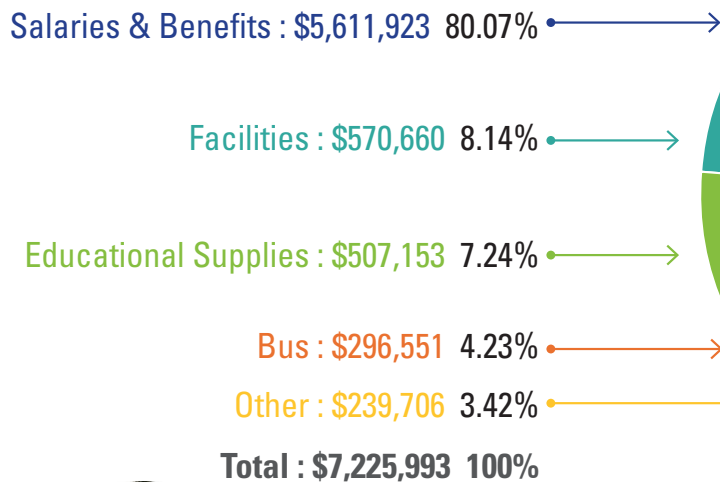

Guide to Giving

Here are ways you can make an impact on the Regina Catholic Education Center through your charitable gifts.

Cash

The most common method to donate is by making an outright cash gift or pledge. Payments can be made via cash, check, credit card or automatic withdrawal.

Securities

Stocks, bonds or mutual fund shares that have appreciated can have an immediate impact and may also provide a tax-advantaged way to give.

Corporate Matching Gifts

A matching gift program provided through your employer or board membership may allow you to increase the value of your gift. Please consult with your employer's human resources director or community outreach director to see if your company has a matching gift program.

Legacy Gifts (*Living the Promise Society*)

A legacy gift is a planned future gift that designates some part of your estate as a donation to the Regina Catholic Education Center/Regina Foundation. Such a gift can enable you to take full advantage of tax laws to accomplish your financial and charitable goals. Below are a few commonly used ways to make a legacy gift:

- Bequest by will or living trust
- Charitable remainder trust, charitable gift annuity, or charitable lead trust
- Beneficiary benefits from IRAs, pensions or financial accounts

Life Insurance

Naming the Regina Foundation as the beneficiary to either all or a portion of an insurance policy is a powerful and simple way to support Regina.

Qualified Charitable Distributions

To be eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) you must be 70½ or older. Simply instruct your IRA trustee to make a distribution directly from your IRA to a qualified charity (please note that a QCD CANNOT be made from a SEP, SIMPLE IRA, 401(k), or 403(b) account). The distribution must be one that would otherwise be taxable to you. You can exclude up to \$100,000 of QCDs from your gross income each year. And if you file a joint return, your spouse (if 70½ or older) can exclude an additional \$100,000 of QCDs from his/her IRA. QCDs count toward satisfying any required minimum distributions (RMDs) that you would otherwise have to receive from your IRA, just as if you had received an actual distribution from the plan. However, distributions that you actually receive from your IRA (including RMDs) and subsequently transfer to a charity cannot qualify as QCDs.
