**AP Courses:**

Students may choose to take an AP Course during their 10<sup>th</sup> grade year. AP Courses are college-level, advanced placement courses. These courses allow students the challenge of a college-level course, while also gaining credit toward high school graduation. Students should be ready for the rigorous constraints of a college-level course. Students who elect to take an AP course, are committed to taking the AP exam in May. The cost of the exam varies each year and is set by the College Board, the company that hosts the AP network. Last year's AP exam fee was \$95 per exam. If a student successfully completes the AP course with a C or above, and completes the AP exam, a weighted GPA will be earned for each semester's AP course. A student who does not complete the AP exam will receive the course grade as an unweighted GPA. The weighted grading system takes into account the additional workload.
