AP Courses are college-level, Advanced Placement Courses. These courses allow students the challenge of a college-level course, while also gaining credit toward high school graduation. Students should be ready for the rigorous constraints of a college-level course before enrolling. Students who elect to take an AP course, are committed to taking the AP exam in May. If a student successfully completes the AP course with a C or above, and completes the AP exam, a weighted GPA will be earned for each semester's AP course. The weighted grading system takes into account the additional workload.
