# **Questions and Answers for Elementary In-Person Learning**

August, 12th 2020

#### **Classroom Cohorts:**

Cohorts are defined by staying with your homeroom classmates and teacher. All elementary classrooms will maintain a minimum of 3-foot social distancing within the classroom. There will be no mixing of students via grade level or other classes.

#### **Special Delivery:**

Students will be traveling to PE, outdoors (weather permitting) via the closest door. All other specials will be delivered in the homeroom classroom.

#### **Rotational Recess:**

All elementary classrooms will have 2-3 15-minute outdoor breaks. This break will include a time where students can get a mask break, prior to going to play. Students will be required to wear their mask during recess. Each homeroom class will be exiting and entering specific doors to minimize hallway traffic. Additionally, classrooms will be assigned a location on the playground, so cohorts are not mixed.

# **Lunch Delivery:**

Lunch delivery will take place in one of three locations-outside tent, classroom, or cafeteria. Social distancing will be followed in each assigned location. Grade levels will not mix and cohorts will not mix during lunch.

#### Arrival:

When students arrive to school, they will be directed to their classroom line on the cement section of the elementary playground. Students should have their mask on, upon arrival to campus. Students will remain in their lines, until classroom teacher escorts them into the building. More detailed information on arrival and dismissal will be coming.

## Dismissal:

New protocols have been established for social distancing by determining new exit doors prior to grouping in your assigned area with your dismissal teacher. No grouping down the main hallway.

## **In Class Protocols:**

These will be shared by your homeroom teacher during the first few days of school. They will include items such as hand washing, sanitizing, social distancing in the room, use of materials, etc.
