1. Numbers - Center-wide numbers have been at 0 for several consecutive days. Committee will review how things look after Spring Break.

2. Events coming up at Regina -

- **April 15 - Good Friday Prayer Services:** Many senior and 5th grade parents and others attend and Regina welcomes this.
- **April 3 to April 9 - Senior Trip to Washington DC:** Need to discuss logistics and health plans should someone become sick or develop COVID.
- **April 20 - Memorial Mass:** in HS gym which traditionally brings about approx 50 outside people. As of today, Regina is planning on this event taking place under normal circumstances.

Events yet to be reviewed by Return to Learn.

- **TBD May 6? - Grandparents Day:** This event can bring several hundred extra people. Will have a large population of aged individuals. May need to break it up into two days or into smaller groups. Discussing activities schedule.
- **May 6 & 7 - JH Spring Play:** Ozma of Oz. Three shows which typically have about 50-75 people per show.
- **May 18 - Scholarship Awards Assembly:** in HS gym. 7-12th grades plus senior parents.
- **May 18 - Scholarship Luncheon:** held in Elem gym. Lunch at long tables. Approx 150 people attend.

3. Three Foot Distance in Classrooms - does this still need to be maintained? Teachers would like to be able to provide more small group instruction. Will check in with medical team members for input.

4. Parents coming in to have lunch with students: mostly impacts elementary, not many for jh/hs. Elementary is still trying to space kids further apart during lunchtime. Committee agrees we should keep spacing at least through two weeks after Spring Break and not have parents coming in for lunch yet.

5. Volunteers - are allowed back in the building at this time. Regina appreciates and needs their help.

6. RTL Committee Meeting Frequency - Committee may change meeting frequency from every week to every other week starting in April, if the numbers remain low. An out of office message will be put on the Covid Questions email directing people to contact an administrator with COVID-related questions.
