Meeting Began at 9:02 AM

1. **Events at Regina** - Ash Wednesday Prayer Services included families/friends attending. The community was happy to be back in the building to participate in these events and students and staff were happy to have them join us. Fish Fry is scheduled to be back on site at Regina, starts tonight - March 4 and goes every Friday through April 8 from 5-8pm.

2. **Italy Trip** - is on as scheduled. The tour company still requires negative covid testing before departure. Some of the other covid restrictions abroad have been relaxed.

3. Numbers - Center-wide numbers have been very low (<6 for over two weeks).

4. **Discussion Regarding Classroom Exposure** - Regina sends exposure letters to families in PK-6 if someone tests positive. Currently there are more than 2 cases in the same PK classroom. Committee decided that when there are more than 2 positive cases in the same class the letter will be amended to strongly recommend that the students/staff wear masks for the next 10 days to help avoid the potential for in-class transmission, especially for the PK level that are not yet able to be vaccinated.

5. Covid Updates on the Regina Website - Discussion regarding if Regina should continue to post covid tracking numbers and information on the website. Many other schools have removed this from their sites or transitioned away from COVID tabs to Return to Learn. The committee decided to keep updating for now to see where numbers are after Spring Break and revisit the topic at that time.

6. RTL Committee Meeting Frequency - Discussion regarding changing meetings from every week to every other week after Spring Break if numbers remain low. For now, will continue to meet weekly.
