1. Johnson County Public Health Guidance for Schools in Fall 2022

- JCPH released guidance that provides info emphasizing the importance of vaccinations, wearing masks indoors in public areas, staying home when sick, if testing positive to stay quarantined for 5 days and then if symptom free may return to school and activities but encouraged to wear a mask until day 10.

2. Current Regina Covid Protocols

- As we approach the start of the 2022-23 school year, we will remind parents and families of the current protocols at Regina Catholic Education Center regarding Covid. We will include information in upcoming Regal Weekly newsletters, as well as update the Covid tabs on the website.
- No changes since the end of the last school year, but good to remind everyone.
- The Covid pages on the website were moved to the About Regina tab.
- We will not be posting the tracking of Covid case numbers for the school at this time.
- We will continue to ask families to report positive cases and direct exposures on the Covid Reporting form linked on the website so that we can do deep cleaning in the rooms that were involved.
- Following up with the Diocese to see if we still need to report covid numbers to them this year.

3. Monkeypox
