



7th Grade Registration Request Information for 2023-2024

We are so excited to plan for another school year and to welcome your soon to be 7th grader to our school! Every spring and summer our administration works diligently to create a schedule that works for each student. **This is information to use in the planning process.** During a class meeting, students will select their requested classes online.

General information:

- There are 8 class periods. Students must have the equivalent of 7 of the 8 class periods filled with academic courses each semester. An academic course is defined as a course where students can earn credit. The remaining 1 class period can be filled with learning center time or a study hall. Students can have all 8 class periods filled with academic coursework.
- All of your core morning classes are scheduled for every school day. Some required courses (such as PE and Language Arts) alternate days all year long. All of these electives alternate days and are only 1 semester long: Computer Applications, Art 1 and 2. Junior High Latin will also be offered and will be 2 semesters long.
- The **Course Description Guide** at **Regina.org** is available to review the full course descriptions, typical sequences and additional information.
- Study Hall vs. Learning Center: Study Hall is monitored by one of the Regina staff. Students will be expected to work on their homework and be productive. In the Learning Center, a Learning Center teacher provides extra support in the areas of organization, accommodation monitoring, and re-teaching as needed based on student need. Students who have been with Mrs. Larson in elementary school benefited from attending the Learning Center.
- I-Ready Reading and I-Ready Math: Students who test below grade-level in Reading and or Math will be placed in I-Ready, based on recommendations and supporting data. In these courses, students will learn skills and strategies for reading and/or math across the curriculum. The program is based on the I-Ready diagnostic online program. Students take a diagnostic placement test and the computer designs an individualized set of lessons for each student. These lessons are based on the Iowa Core Standards. Students will continue individually to work on specific lessons. These courses are a supplement to the regular curriculum until the student reaches grade-level proficiency. Students who receive math or reading assistance from Mrs. Larson are possible candidates for one or both courses.
- This registration request process allows Regina to best plan for teacher and section numbers. It is important to register for the classes you intend to take. Course offerings may change based on student interest and teacher availability.

REQUIRED COURSES

Every student in 7th grade will be registered by the school for the following courses:		<p>Music Every student in 7th grade is required to take a minimum of 1 music course, but must register in PowerSchool for the correct course. Students can choose from: Band, Choir, General Music or Orchestra</p> <p>Math Every student in 7th grade is required to take 1 math course. Students will be placed in a math course that best suits their math experience and proficiency. Math placement is based on teacher recommendations, grades in math and supporting data. Regina staff will adjust a math selection at a later date, if the student initially chose the wrong course.</p>

If students choose to add Learning Center or Study Hall, it should be figured in as 1 class period, even though it isn't added in the overall credits on PowerSchool.

How to Officially Register for the 2023 - 2024 School Year

1. On the student Chromebook, go to <https://davenportdiocese.powerschool.com/public>
2. Bookmark the website (Ctrl D) for later reference.
3. Log on to the student account using your new username and password.
4. On the left, click the tab labeled *Class Registration*.
(Course Registration will be open until April 14, 2023)
5. Once there, read through the instructions
6. Select the necessary courses first, followed by the electives.
7. When complete, review the list to confirm it has all of the correct courses.
8. Review your selections, and click the submit button on the bottom of the screen.
9. Log out. Save your username and password somewhere safe for later use.
